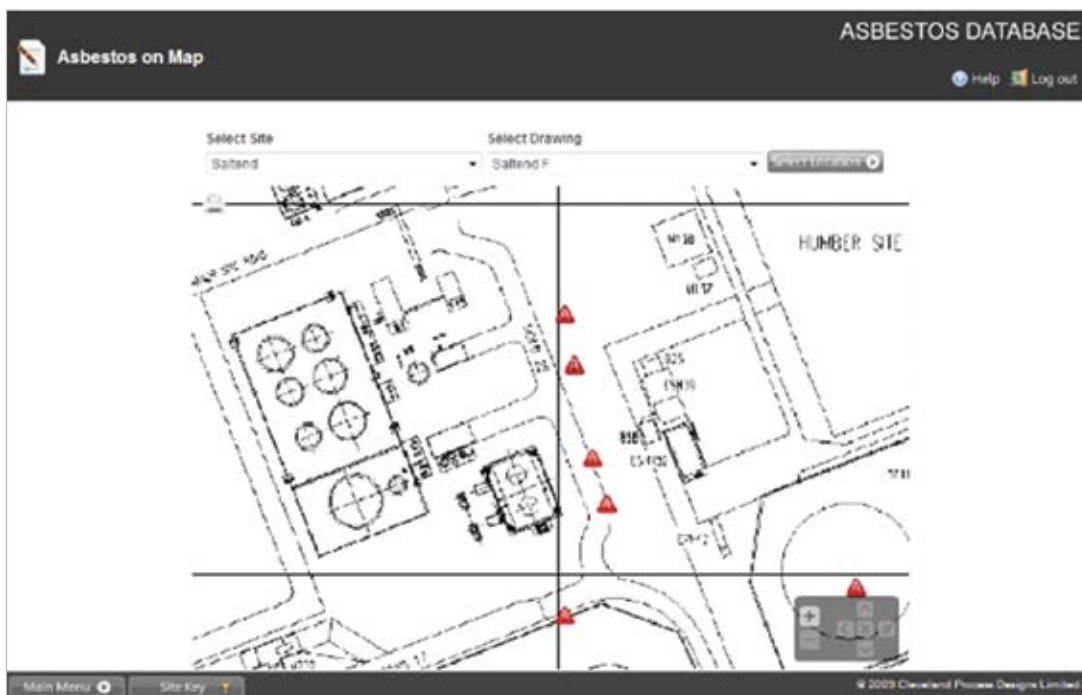

## BETTER COMPLIANCE MANAGEMENT

In an environment where it is imperative to demonstrate conformity with standards for the management of asbestos within premises, iSurvey provides an online secure data facility to store and manage compliance data, photographs, risk assessments, analysis documentation and historical data for improved compliance management.

In 2011 CPD completed the construction of its data centre network, backed up by Escrow agreements, in a bid to offer its customers a repository where asbestos data gathered is no longer lost - the goal being that historical data will be available for decades to come.

## IMPROVES SAFETY

iSurvey grants premises owners the ability to manage asbestos information for all areas of their premises (buildings, process areas and off-site), reducing the risk of exposure to staff and contract personnel.

Access can be given on an Administration or Read Only basis (via a secure username & password) to key personnel, such as permit issuers and team leaders, allowing those with responsibility the necessary access to input and modify asbestos data and at the same time restricting those that only need to read asbestos data, company management plans and the latest health and safety information.
